



## Cat and Kitten Diarrhea Protocol

## **Under Six Weeks**

See protocol "Common Neonatal Problems and Medications"

## Six Weeks and Over

Consult vet if severe watery or bloody diarrhea, inappetance, lethargy, painful, will not get up, pale, weight loss, vomiting. Especially if 8 weeks or younger!

Consider panleuk testing if

- under 4 months of age
- diarrhea +/- vomiting or not eating
- kitten has been in shelter for less than one week or
- history of possible exposure to panleuk positive kittens.
- 1. If BAR, eating, gaining weight and diarrhea <u>one day or **more**</u>
  - a. If email
    - i. Rx. Panacur SID x 3 days if not done within last 3 weeks
    - ii. Rx. Marquis Paste 0.3mL/lb once
  - b. If present
    - i. Rx. Panacur and Marquis as indicated above
    - ii. If 6-12wks old administer Pen G SQ once
- 2. If BAR, eating, gaining weight and no improvement in diarrhea for additional 72 hours:
  - a. Rx Praziquantel 7.5mg/kg PO once
  - b. Rx. Metro 20mg/kg PO SID x 5 days
  - c. Schedule an appointment in 48-72 hours
    - i. Notify foster/adopter to cancel appointment if diarrhea resolves/resolving
- 3. If diarrhea persists after 5 days (still BAR, eating, etc)
  - a. SQF 15mL/lb
  - b. Fecals will be only by DVM request
  - c. Notify vet for plan

If cat/kitten still having diarrhea after these steps are done or if any nausea/anorexia occur – consult vet for any further treatment/plan.
