Call your city shelter and make a found pet report. Email them the photos. \*Tell them if the cat is sick or injured.


## TAKE THE CAT TO A VETERINARIAN OR PET SUPPLY STORE TO SCAN FOR A MICROCHIP!

Post photos of the cat on a Lost & **Found Facebook Page for your** community, as well Nextdoor and Craigslist. Be descriptive, include as much detail as possible & add how they can contact you.

**Create colorful FOUND posters** and post in a 1 mile radius around where the cat was found.

\*Do not take the cat into your home or move it unless it is sick or injured. Many cats are indoor/outdoor and are able to find their way back home. You may place cat food and/or water out for the cat, though.

Do not feed cats or kittens milk.
